The role of the Committee

- Be a catalyst and resource for churches to develop a comprehensive *Mission* programme
- Help develop passion for Mission at the parish level through education and events
- Work closely with parish leadership to create a Mission culture
- Encourage parishes to set aside a portion of their budget for *Mission*
- Encourage parishes to establish a Missions committee or appoint a Missions co-ordinator





The role of the Committee

- Engage with our the current ANiC Mission partners
 - Anglican Relief and Development Fund Canada (ARDFC)
 - Christian Mission to Jews Canada (CMJ)
 - Anglican Multicultural Mission in Canada (AMMiC)
 - Mission to Cuba (led by Bishop Dorrington)
- Engage with overseas Anglican Provinces and Dioceses
 - Encourage active participation in all aspects of GAFCON and GFCA
 - Host visiting Primates and Bishops
 - Encourage parishes to partner with overseas dioceses and parishes





The role of the Committee

- Engage with churches in the Anglican Dioceses of the Yukon and Arctic
- Other initiatives....
 - > Support and work in local food banks, soup kitchens
 - > Support other overseas missionaries and mission societies
 - > Support justice in 3rd world countries.
