ANIC is part of a resurgence in North America of orthodox Anglicanism – the historic, Biblically faithful, authentically Anglican way of following Jesus and being part of the "One Holy Catholic and Apostolic Church".

Globally, Anglicans number 70 million, the majority in Biblically faithful African churches.
