Seven areas where cell-church can make a church more effective in fruitfulness.

1. Effective for Community

Many Christian leaders are stressed out by church programs and activities, resulting in failure in relationships.

2. Effective for Pastoral Care

There is a limit to what one man can do. Traditional pastors face the 200 - barrier.

3. Effective for Greater Harvest

Evangelism is not a department. It is the mission of the whole body of Christ.

4. Effective for Spiritual Ministry

1 Cor 12:7-11 Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good. To one there is given through the Spirit the message of wisdom, to another the message of knowledge by means of the same Spirit, to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by that one Spirit, to another miraculous powers, to another prophecy, to another distinguishing between spirits, to another speaking in different kinds of tongues, and to still another the interpretation of tongues. All these are the work of one and the same Spirit, and he gives them to each one, just as he determines.

God has given every believer at least a gift to minister and to build. The church life is lived out in a Cell.

5. Effective for Nurturing New Believers.

Acts 2:41-42 Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day. They devoted themselves to the apostles; teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.

The Cell provides a loving environment for teaching and learning God's Word for life change.

6. Effective for Broadening the Leadership Base.

Extend the reach, the time, the impact and the results of one man's ministry. Train leaders, and multiply effectiveness.

7. Effective for Rapid Church Planting.

3 – 4 cells can form a church. Planting a cell will lead to planting a congregation.
