ANiC Bishop Malcom Harding

Bishop Malcolm Harding was born in England, and was a cradle Anglican. He came to Canada with his family in 1947. He studied for the Anglican Ministry at Huron College (University of Western Ontario) graduating in 1962. He is married to Marylou, and has three children and four grandchildren.

Bishop Malcolm was ordained in 1962 and served briefly in the Diocese of Fredericton. He studied social work at the University of Manitoba, graduating in 1966, and worked for a period of seven years for the Manitoba Department of Health and Social Development.

In the late 60's he became exposed to the charismatic renewal and experienced a further conversion and a new enthusiasm to serve our Lord. Ordained a priest in 1973, Bishop Malcolm served for five years in a multipoint rural parish in Manitoba, followed by 14 years in an urban parish. Elected Bishop in 1992, he retired in 2001. Beginning in 2001, Bishop Malcolm served as the Ambassador for Anglican Renewal Ministries for several years.

In November 2007, Bishop Malcolm relinquished his ministry as a Bishop in the Anglican Church of Canada, and was received by Bishop Harvey under the authority of Archbishop Venables of the province of the Southern Cone into the Anglican Network in Canada, where he served as Bishop Suffragan until retiring in 2009. He continues to make himself available on a part time basis for teaching on parish renewal and church growth.
