Directions to South Delta Baptist Church – conference venue

South Delta Baptist Church is easy to find, located right at the entrance to the community of Tsawwassen. If you've ever taken the Tsawwassen Ferry to Vancouver Island you've practically driven right by the church.

From the Vancouver International Airport

Head west on Grant McConachie Way (2.8 km, 5 mins)
Take the ramp to Highway 99 south toward Seattle/Ferries (0.8 km, 1 min)
Merge onto Sea Island Way (1.3 km, 2 mins)
Merge onto Highway 99 south via the ramp to Seattle/Ferries (11 km, 8 mins)
Take exit 28 for Highway 17 toward BC Ferries (0.3 km)
Keep right at the fork, follow signs for Tsawwassen/Ferries and merge onto Highway 17 south (7.5 km, 6 mins)
At 56th Street you'll come to a large intersection with two lanes turning left into the town of Tsawwassen. Turn left and the church is about one block from the intersection.

From Vancouver

Take the Oak Street Bridge or the Knight Street Bridge. Both bridges eventually arrive at Highway 99. The Oak Street Bridge automatically becomes Highway 99 after you cross the bridge going south. The Knight Street Bridge leads to Highway 99 if you follow the BC Ferries directional signs. From there follow the Airport instructions above.

From the Fraser Valley

Take Highway 10 westbound. When you arrive at the Highway 99 interchange (by the Chevron station), you can choose to enter the freeway or remain on Highway 10 for a more relaxing trip parallel to the freeway. If taking the Highway 99 freeway, follow the directions for White Rock traffic above. If taking Highway 10, follow it past the Hydro substation until you arrive at Highway 17, a large intersection with two left turn lanes. Turn left towards the ferry terminal. At 56th Street you'll come to another large intersection with two lanes turning left into the town of Tsawwassen. Turn left and the church is a block or two from the intersection.

From White Rock (and the Peace Arch boarder crossing)

Take Highway 99 west to the turnoff at Highway 17 just before the George Massey tunnel. There's a traffic light at the overpass. Turn left onto the overpass, heading south along Highway 17 towards the ferry terminal. Follow the highway for about 8 miles. At 56th Street you'll come to a large intersection with two lanes turning left into the town of Tsawwassen. Turn left and the church is a block or two from the intersection.

From the BC Ferry terminal (coming from Vancouver Island)

Continue on Highway 17 until you reach 56th Street – a large intersection. Turn south (right) into the town of Tsawwassen. The church is a block or two from the intersection.
