- Dates:** **April 25-26, 2008** (Friday and Saturday)
Registration begins 8:15 am Friday; Conference concludes 5 pm Saturday.
Also on Sunday, Archbishop Venables will speak at a Vancouver-area church, while other Communion leaders will speak in other Vancouver-area churches.
- Location:** **South Delta Baptist Church, Tsawwassen, BC** (See map attached)

- Registration:** Register early to take advantage of the best rate. Payment must be received for registration to be complete. You can register online (www.anglicannetwork.ca) or by mailing this registration form, with your your cheque. - We've kept registration rates very low to ensure the conference is affordable. These rates likely will not cover our costs, however. If you can afford more, the registration process will include an opportunity to make a donation to help us meet expenses.
Some may still struggle with the costs, however. So, we suggest ANiC parishes consider fund raising events to help defray costs for parishioners wishing to attend. If you require financial assistance but are not able to get help from your parish, you can apply for a **bursary** by contacting the Rev Dr Trevor Walters at 604 855-9315 or email walters34@shaw.ca.
- Schedule:** A conference schedule will be available soon. The main celebration and commissioning service with Archbishop Gregory Venables will be Saturday afternoon.
- Lodging:** **Conference hotel** – A special conference rate is available at the [Coast Tsawwassen Inn](#). Please make your own hotel arrangements, mentioning the Anglican Network conference to get our special rate. This hotel is within walking distance of the conference facility. Since all rooms are one bedroom suites, if you wish to save further on accommodation, you can "buddy up".
Please note that this is a small hotel with a limited number of rooms, so we urge you to **book quickly**. Please note, **the special ANiC rate is only guaranteed for bookings made by March 24**. Hotel information is attached.

Transport:

As much as possible, we encourage you to make your own transportation arrangements.

Airport - If you are arriving at the **Vancouver International Airport (YVR)**, and are not planning to rent a car for your time in Vancouver, we will be coordinating taxi service – arranging for 2-3 people per taxi – to and from the airport. There will be an additional charge of **\$40/person** for this two-way transportation between the conference hotel and the airport. (Or \$20 for one-way transport between the airport and the conference hotel.) More information will be provided closer to the conference date detailing these arrangements.

If you are not using the conference hotel, please make your own transportation arrangements. If you are being billeted, your hosts may be able to provide transportation.

Ferry – If you are coming into the BC Ferry Terminal in Tsawwassen, the Coast Tsawwassen Inn offers a free shuttle for guests staying at that hotel.

If you have particular transportation concerns, please [email us](#) as soon as possible. We will do our best to arrange to assist you. Again, if you will not have your own transportation and are not being billeted, we encourage you to book at the recommended conference hotel to facilitate travel to the conference venue. (The hotel is walking distance from the church.)

Air travel:

To minimize costs, we suggest you purchase your plane ticket on a seat sale. However, if you are not able to do that, we have negotiated a special conference discount for *regular fare* flights to Vancouver on WestJet. The discount gives you 10% off the best available regular fare at the time of booking and is good during the period April 22-29. Please make your booking through the **WestJet Specialty Sales Team** quoting our conference account **QC #5209**. To take advantage of this rate, you should complete the booking request form and submit it to Westjet by [fax](#) or [email](#).
