

- Formed after the Diocese of Toronto announced it would proceed with same-sex blessings
- May 2009 Began discernment process
- Summer Began monthly prayer/study meetings
- July Moved to larger facility
- Leadership team developed
- Sept Moved to bi-weekly meetings
- Oct 22 Welcomed officially as Church Plant Project
- Average attendance of 19-20
